History AutoCAD's original developer name was "Autocad, Inc.". The company name and the copyright notice of AutoCAD also were changed to Autodesk, Inc., in 1997. Autodesk acquired 3D drawing program PLOTWARE in August 1999. Before that, PLOTWARE was a product of SolidWorks. SolidWorks split its product line into Autodesk and Microstation. PLOTWARE was renamed SolidWorks Graphics (SWG). Autodesk no longer markets SWG, it is sold as a freeware product in the Autodesk Application Alliance. Version history AutoCAD versions Autodesk AutoCAD LT AutoCAD LT is the first, original product released for DOS and Windows. The first version of AutoCAD was released in 1990. AutoCAD LT was originally created by Autodesk as a re-skinned version of AutoCAD for DOS. The DOS version of AutoCAD was known as AutoCAD LT. In 1992 the name of the software product was changed to AutoCAD for DOS and AutoCAD LT was renamed AutoCAD for Windows. In 1994 AutoCAD LT was rewritten from a DOS port of AutoCAD to a Windows port of AutoCAD. These later versions are known as AutoCAD LT/WS. AutoCAD LT was originally a DOS-only product and was the first AutoCAD product. It was also the first professional-level CAD program. It was the first CAD program to offer some features of a BIM program. AutoCAD LT supported all the core AutoCAD features and was thus an "AutoCAD on steroids." It offered many unique features, including graphical styles, drawing sheets, drawing conventions and editing features. It was easy to use, but it required the use of specialized commands. AutoCAD LT was DOS-only for five years (1992–1997) and it had no migration support from DOS to Windows. When the product name was changed to AutoCAD for Windows in 1997, it also included a Windows port of the same product. This was due to changes in AutoCAD licensing and the inability to continue the DOS-only product. In 1999 Autodesk released AutoCAD LT/WS, a port of AutoCAD LT to Windows.
