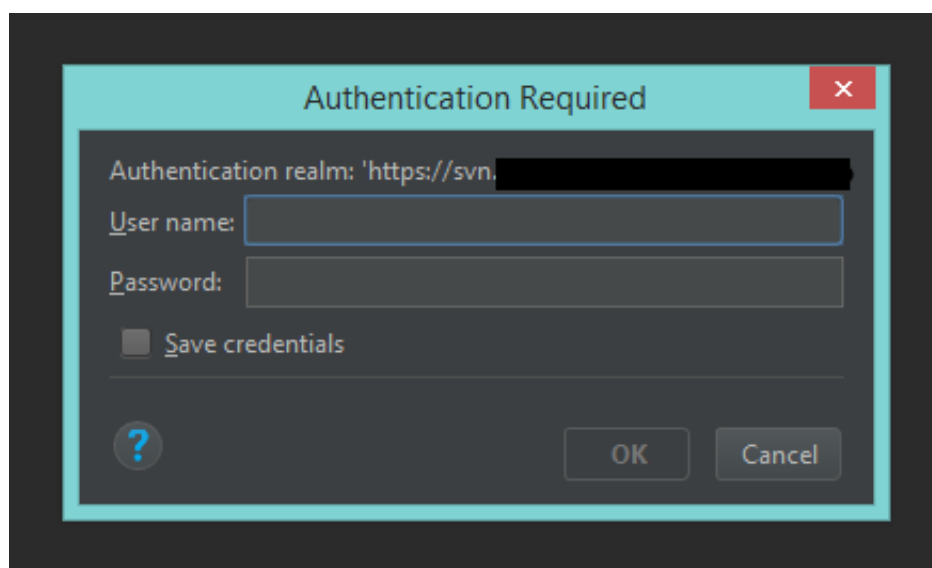

Both submenus also have a (recursively) equivalent..
